

For many years, Martin (born 25th April 1940) was one of Britain's band of itinerant rally co-drivers, competing successfully for a variety of international rally teams and learning first-hand the complex but fascinating world of rallying. The friendships among drivers and teams remain and now help to provide a unique insight for his current work, the worldwide syndication of news and stories about rallying – and the authorship of *Rothmans World Rallying* annuals.

Based in Woking, Surrey, Martin originally trained as a lawyer, an area where experience in today's professional rally business does no harm. His competition career took him to the teams run by Ford Vauxhall, Renault, Lancia, Toyota, Datsun and many others, Increasingly the "insider" experience helps give a truer perspective to a journalist, and this is much appreciated by "Motor" magazine in England, for whom Martin is retained as Rallies Contributor.

Trained as a photographer. Hugh (born 2nd March 1945) has become the most experienced and respected member of the freelance gypsy group of rally photographers. Based in Salisbury. England, Hugh travels to a different rally almost every week, and has photographed cars in action in every continent except Antarctica!
